Important Notes

- This document assumes that you have already installed a new copy of MediaCP somewhere on your server. It is not possible to upgrade from ShoutcastCP to MediaCP. You must install them separately then use this import tool.
- **Please make sure you have the latest version of Media Control Panel.**
You can do this from MediaCP -> Administration -> Update Cast-Control.
- **Your MediaCP must contain no users or servers besides the Super Administrator account.**
The import may fail or break if you run this with other users/servers. The reason behind this is that the import uses the same user id's and server id's as the original shoutcastcp.



1. Import Guide

The import tool will copy all your accounts and shoutcast servers into the MediaCP

1. Open [http://\[YourDomain\]/mediacp/other/import/shoutcastcp.php](http://[YourDomain]/mediacp/other/import/shoutcastcp.php)
2. Copy the **./content/** directory from your ShoutcastCP into your MediaCP directory.
The import script will rewrite your playlist files to be compatible with the new control panel.
3. Press "Continue the ShoutcastCP Import Process" to continue.
4. Enter the database details of your ShoutcastCP (not the MediaCP).
You can find these In the database.php file of your ShoutcastCP installation directory.
5. Click Import Now. The process may take up to 30 seconds to complete.
6. **Recommended Extra Step**
Reboot the shoutcast services into Cast-Control MediaCP.
Be sure to replace [WebUser] with the user account your MediaCP cron is configured under and replacing [InstallDir] with the full system path to MediaCP.

```
killall sc_serv;  
sudo -u [WebUser] php [InstallDir]/scanner/cron.php bitrate=1
```

Your services should now be restarted.
